

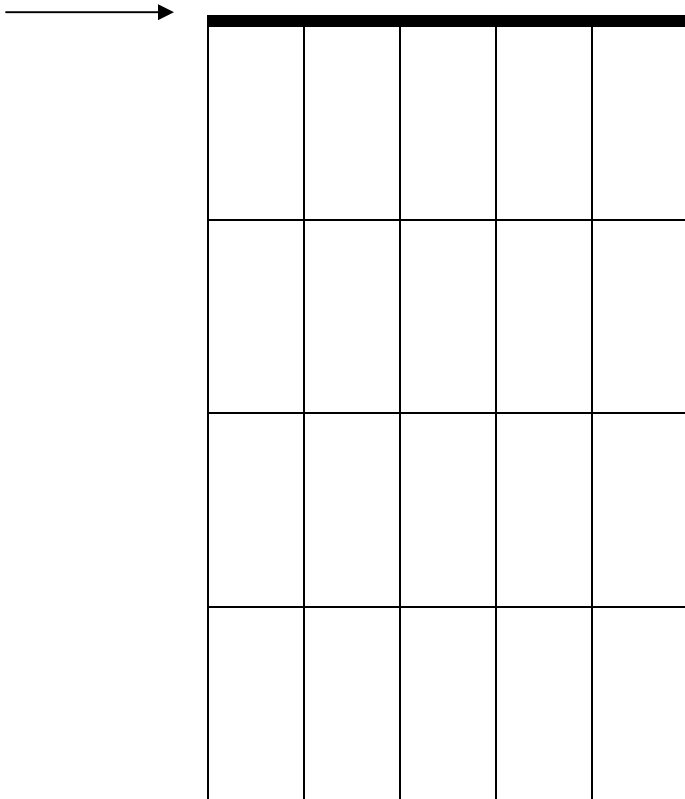

**Directions:** Draw the Chord Diagrams for the chords identified below.

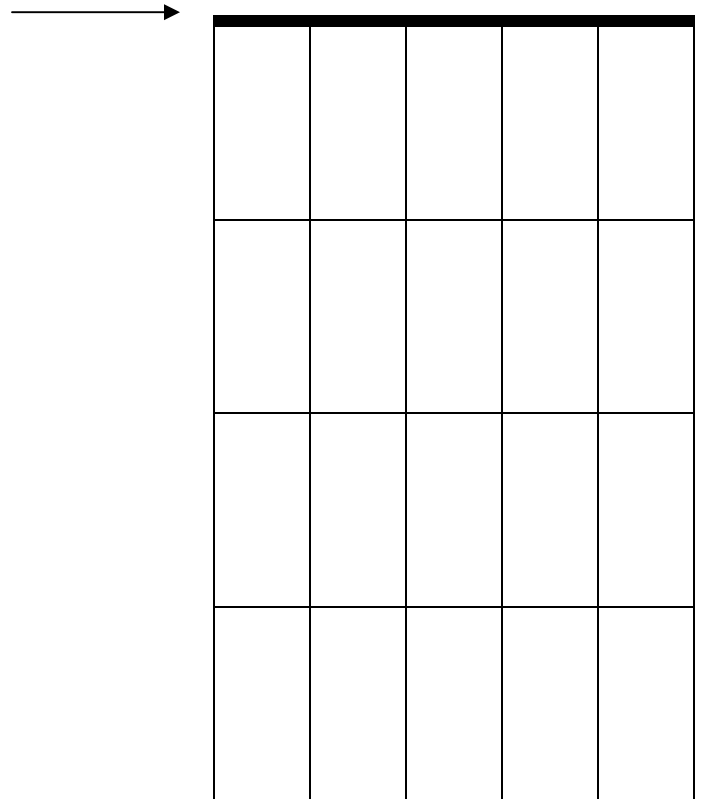
Steps:

1. Label the "nut" (top, **bold** line).
2. Label the frets with numbers, going from top fret to bottom fret.
3. Label the strings with number 1-6, starting with #1 on the right (6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1).
4. Mark any "open" strings with an "O" above those strings.
5. Mark any "don't play" strings with an "X" above those strings.
6. Do not mark above any strings that you will put your finger on the fret.
7. Draw a circle on the string above the appropriate fret for the one(s) you need to press down for this chord.
8. Write the appropriate finger number in the circle you just drew above the fret.
9. Check your work, then copy the name of the chord underneath the "Chord" line.
